I briefly observed the bird before it flew. It responded to an Eastern Screech-Dw) tape by giving a comple of rich chip notes. However, just as I located the bird it flew out of sight. The only field mark I could see was a yellow rump patch. No one else was able to observe the bird before it flew. The bird was approximately 30 feet away. This individual was located adjacent to the Mississippi Kiver about 2 miles next of Illinois City. Illinois in Ruk Island Connety. It was in thick undergrowth surrounding a small coniterous stand. I was using Leica Ultra 10x42 binoculars.
