The finch-type bill was easily recognizable as was the white outer with the large white cheek patch, and the brilliant but brown breast, nape, and throat. The white shoulder patch was also mentioned and approved by the other with about 150 Lapland longspurs and about 12 Horned larks. It walked of the spurs making their usual hoping feeding system. |

Similar species: how eliminated: The bird was quickly picked out of the group of about 150 of lapland Longspors which were in various plumages. When this species is in 3/4 breeding plumage it is easily distinguished.
