Similar species and how eliminated: Scarlot tanager is only similar sp. Reds are different. Scarlets are a much richer more vivid red than the almost flat red of a summer. Scarlets show block wings i Tail. Summer has a bigger bill. (very obvious). Hepatic Tanager should show dark bill + gray check patch. Did any one disagree or have reservations about identification?

Viewing conditions: give lighting, distance (how measured), and optical equipment: The day was overcest, sun was certainly no problem, but There was good light and we were only about 50' away from perched bind. We both use Bth 7x35 biocs.
