

BIRDS: VERIFYING DOCUMENTATION OF AN EXTRAORDINARY SIGHT RECORD.

1. Species House Finch 2. Number: one male
 3. Location Brookside Park, Ames, Story County, Iowa
 4. Date: 12 October 1985 5. Time Bird seen: 30 sec's to abt 3 pm
 6. Description of size, shape and color-pattern (describe in great detail all parts of the plumage, and beak and feet coloration, in addition, to the diagnostic characteristics, but include only what actually was seen in the field):
about size of House Sparrow. general color brown, white belly; head, throat & breast a somewhat orangy red; brown streaks on sides of breast and belly.
