Bird was captured in a Potter's Trap, banded and examined. Released the next morning. Length - 4 7/8", 123 mm. Wing Cord - 2 3/4", 70 mm. Eye ring broken by black eyeline. Supercilliary line - buff. Crown stripped with some rufous. Throat - white. Breast gray. Rump - gray. Browinsh gray ear patch. Tail had one badly worn feather left. Wing bars not clean white. Nape - gray becoming brownish with dark streaks at base of neck. Flesh legs and feet. Bill dark on top, light underneath. Repeatedly scolding with "chip" during time of confinement. Tree sparrows were caught along with the chipping sparrow and could be compared side by side.

Similar species and how eliminated: Tree sparrow too large. Cap with only a few rufous feathers. No central breast spot. No black eyeline. Buff supercilliary line. Breast was gray as compared with buff on clay colored sparrow also gray rump instead of brown. Did any one disagree or have reservations about identification? NO
