Lee Zieke Lee and I found the Fox Sparrow in a brushy fencerow, at the SE corner of Cardinal Marsh, during a mid-morning visit. The fencerow is across the road from an old home site. This focality consistently has concentrations of spavrows, including Fox Sparrow, during both spring and fall migration.

Lee and I were observing a flock of Song and Whitethroated Sparrows, when hee called out Fox Sparrow.
I soon spotted the bird and we observed it flow about a minute at a distance of about 10 yards, We saw it again a few minutes later while we continued to scan the flock, and also located a Lincoln's Sparrow. We noted the rusty red color of the wings, tail, and heavy blotching on the underparts, the bird had a chualty appearance, compared to the other sparrows present. We are both very familiar with this species. hee sees it regularly, in migration, at her Willowgleto Nursery home.

I often find sparrows at unusually early fall dates at this Cardinal Marsh locality but did not realize that this was a record early date for Fox Sparrow.
