Northern Mockingbird - 1 bird on May 6 at Ottumwa, Wapello Co.

Blue-gray Gnatcatcher - 2 birds at Wildcat Den State Park, Muscatine Co. and 2 at Lake Darling State Park, Washinton Co. on May 6.

Parula Warbler -1 bird on May 6 at Lake Darling State Park, Washington Co.

Black-throated Green Warbler - 1 bird on May 6 at Wildcat Den State Park,
Muscatine Co.

Summer Tanager - a pair on May 6 at Waubonsie State Park, Fremont Co.
