Sharebirds		7-23	✓ First good sized flocks noted at Sweet M. - Many present there on 7-29. Most were common sp. but on 7-29 I had a min. of 20 stilt sandpapers at Sweet M. which is most in one place for me. Note: Most of these sharebirds seemed to be adults in breeding plumage (except Wilson's Phalarope).
✓ Upland Sandpaper	2	6-26	South of Denver, Ia. - apparently near a PIK field - new location for me
✓ Caspian tern	1	7-24	Sandpit in Waterloo
✓ Chuck-will's-widow	1	7-15	N. of Waubesa St. PK
