Saturday March 10 I visited Pool Slough at New Albin. An adult Bald Eagle was active in the nest cup of the larger, northern most of the 2 nests north of the road along the south edge of Pool Slough. Between approximately 11:15 - 11:30 AM CST the bird could be seen moving about, raising + lowering the head. Two adults were perched nearby - about 100 yards - and two adults flew south across the slough.

Also at Pool Slough on March 10 were two N. Harriers hunting, male + female, four Rough-legged Hawks and one Kestrel.

An adult has been "on" the nest at Reno, Minnesota about 5 miles directly north of the Pool Slough site since Feb. 25.
