Criteria for Iowa Important Bird Area (IBA) Site Selections

Category 1. Sites important to endangered or threatened species in Iowa.

This category includes the current list of Threatened or Endangered bird species for Iowa (listed below). Iowa includes any federally listed species on its lists, so those species are also included on the state list.

Category 2. Sites important to species of high conservation priority in Iowa.

Species selected by the Technical Committee as being of high conservation priority. An area has to have at least three species from this category in order to be nominated. This should insure that an area really is an important area for birds.

Category 3. Sites that contain rare or unique habitat within the state or an exceptional representative of a natural habitat, and that hold important species or species assemblages largely restricted to a distinctive habitat type.

Presumably such sites will include some species from the lists in categories 1 and 2 although the site might just be an especially good woodland, grassland, or other area.

Category 4. A site that regularly holds significant concentrations of one or more species.

The following criteria were selected:

- 4a. Waterfowl a threshold of at least 500 waterfowl in winter or 1,000 in migration. Canada Geese were specifically excluded in these counts.
- 4b. Gulls and Terns a threshold of at least 1,000 gulls or 100 terns with the following qualifiers: 5,000 for Franklin's Gull, 250 for Black Tern.
- 4c. Shorebirds a threshold of at least 500 shorebirds.
- 4d. Wading birds a threshold of at least 25 breeding pairs or 100 feeding or migratory birds.
- 4e. Raptors a threshold of at least 1,000 total migratory raptors (seasonal total). We also added a category of 100 for wintering birds such as Bald Eagle.
- 4f. Landbirds No threshold limits were established (see attachment for details).
- 4g. Single-species concentrations a threshold of at least 5% of statewide population for a species (e.g., concentrations of American White Pelicans or Double-crested Cormorants).

Category 5. Sites important for long-term research and/or monitoring that contribute substantially to ornithology, bird conservation, and/or education.

We noted that some of the raptor viewing sites (e.g., Hitchcock Area, Grammar Grove) might fit in better in this category than in 4e above.

Abbreviated Iowa Important Bird Area (IBA) Summary - May 17, 2003

- 1. Between the 2002 IOU Spring Conference and the end of 2002, <u>59 individuals</u> nominated <u>273 habitats</u> for IBA recognition and priority treatment. Nearly everyone used the easy online nomination process at <u>www.iowabirds.org/IBA</u>. To keep up with IBA developments, return here often.
- 2. The Iowa IBA Technical Committee evaluated all nominations and was very pleased with the participation by birders from across the state. The Tech. Comm. moved 182 nominations forward in the IBA site identification process. (58 nominations were rejected for sites not meeting criteria, 34 were rejected for being a duplicate or for overlap with another nomination, and one nomination was separated into two nominations.)
- 3. Prizes donated to the IBA Program by <u>Eagle Optics</u> were awarded to: Lee Schoenewe for submitting the most nominations that were moved forward in the process (Spotting Scope w/ 20-60 variable power magnification and a Tripod, valued at \$1,000), Danny Akers for submitting the second most (Ranger Platinum Class 8 X 42 bins by Eagle Optics, valued at \$400), and Mike Dooley for submitting the third most (Denali 7 X 32 bins by Eagle Optics, valued at \$200).

Your Challenge for the Coming Months

The beauty of IBAs is that they will form a <u>network of essential habitats</u> that connect together Canada, the United States, and Latin America in the Western Hemisphere – and indeed the entire globe – and will allow for the first time, prioritization of habitat-level bird conservation actions. Our program focuses on those species selected by the Iowa IBA Technical Committee as being MOST in need of help – the <u>Iowa IBA Criteria Species</u>.

* * * But our Iowa IBA Technical Committee needs to receive sufficient bird data for each of the 182 nominated habitats in order to make final decisions on whether or not those habitats can be officially recognized as Important Bird Areas (or IBAs).

IBA status will allow the IBA Program together with its partnering public agencies, private conservation organizations, businesses and individuals, to begin Phase II and Phase III. These next steps include: in-depth habitat analysis, long-term bird monitoring, initiating education programs at IBAs, development of IBA-level bird conservation plans, and the vital habitat restoration, enhancement, and improved management that future generations of birds and people each deserve...
