1st sighted Sept 19 (GB) numbered 150 increased to 300 by the 21st to a high of 430 by the 24th. most had left by the 30th but about 15 stragglers stayed till Oct 2

Double-crested Comorants

4 on Sept 24 2 on Sept 28th

Cattle Egrets-15 sighted in one flock in pasture on south side of the lake.

Great Egrets

1 on Sept 24 - 12 Sept 1 - 1 Aug 16

Black-crowned Night Herons

3 on Sept 26 (RRR) - 2 on Aug 9 (Skunk river in Marion county)

Least Bittern - one on Aug 13

White-fronted geese - 6 on Sept 26

Ducks-thousands of Blue-winged Teal moved in the Lst of Sept and were gone again by within 4 days. through Sept and into Oct all species were scarce. Lage Oct and early Nov, some of the common migrants started to move in, middle Nov estimate by the wildlife biologists was 35,000 Mallards. (check Gladys Black report for more ducks).

No plovers or sandpipers observed in Red Rock area this fall other than Killdeer and spotted sandpiper.

Gulls - thousands for Ring-billed Gulls througout latter part of Oct and into November, with a few Bonoparte's and Herring.

Yellow-billed cuckoo - one on Sept 3

Common Nighthawk - flock of 24 apparently migrating south on Sept 3

Short-billed Mardh wren - 8 on Aug 20 (Iowa river in Hardin county)

Eastern Bluebird 1st week in Oct thre flocks 12, 20, 23.

Warblers - only the common species sighted - many individuals, but only a few species.

Myrtle, Tennessee, Nashville, Black and White - all intSept and early Oct.
