\*Loggerhead Shrike very few

\*Bell's Vireo none

Yellow-throated, Red-eyed and Warbling Vireos very few

Blue-winged Warbler very rare in Polk Co. seen on 6 June (Wm Boller)

\*Yellow Warbler very few

\*Am. Redstart few apparently nested in Jester Park, only report

Dickcissel few due to lack of habitat

Towhee no report

Vesper Sparrow usually not scarce, but few

Lark Sparrow no report formerly not uncommon breeder
