Northern Harriers (2) in whitebreast bay area - June 5

single Yellow-billed cuckoo _ July 22

Cliff swallows are nesting on the face of the Dam, but have deserted other areas used for nesting sites in previous years.

other observations;

different individuals, with several sightings

Common Egrets (3) - July 2

Forster's Terns (22) - most of July

Caspian Terns (5) - July 7

Black Terns (25) - most of July

only shorebirds to be sighted in the past two months are Pectoral and Spotted sandpipers, Killdeer, and Greater Yellowlegs.
