Barned owl 1-17 Woodlawn - the end of Ia but going N to Jefferson St
Long-eared owl 1-14 with Milt & Rich at Reservoir
Common Flicker 1-17 Woodlawn, 3 on 2-6 Hickory Hill
Pileated 1-14 Reservoir with Mike & Rich
Red headed woodpecker one seen several times on old 218 past West Overlook
Hairy 1-1 thru 1-5 at my feeders
Carolina Wren (2) 1-17 Woodlawn
Am. Robin seen and heard several times in Hickory Hill park
Brown Headed Cowbird 1-17 Woodlawn again on 2-9
Pint Grosbeak 1-13 Hickory Hill (4) seen with Tom Kent ^{doe.} total 5
also seen 2-7 1 male in St. Joseph Cemetery
Common Redpoll $\begin{cases} 7 \\ \text{Pink Siskin} \end{cases}$ both seen at various dates in HMP
also Purple Finch

Birds seen outside the Iowa city area

Mallard, Black, Pintail, Common Goldeneye and 1 common Merganser all on the Cedar River in Cedar Rapids 2-9
many mallard, common goldeneye a few common Merganser and 1 Buff-breasted on the Mississippi at Davenport 2-11
also seen in Davenport 1 Pileated woodpecker in Enchanted Island ²⁻¹¹
and the Evening Grosbeaks (4) PETE PERKINS said were near his house like many others, I also saw the Hoary Redpoll and female Whit-winged crossbill in C.R./Marion.
