Hairy 1-1 thru 1-5 at my feeders

Carolina wren (2) 1-17 woodlawn

Am. Robin seen and heard several times in Hickory Hill park

Brown Heded Cowbird 1-17 woodlawn again on 2-9

Pink Grosbeak 1-13 Hickory Hill (M) seen with Tom Kent doc.  
also seen 2-7 1 male in St. Joseph Cemetery total 5

Common Redpoll } both seen at various dates in HHP

Pink siskin } also Purple Finch

Birds seen outside the Iowa city area

mallard, Black, Pintail, Common Goldeneye and 1 common Merganser  
all on the Cedar River in Cedar Rapids 2-9

many mallard, common Goldeneye a few common Merganser and 1 <sup>male</sup> Buffbreast  
on the Mississippi at Davenport 2-11

also seen in Davenport 1 Pileated woodpecker in Enchanted Island <sup>2-11</sup>  
and the Evening Grosbeaks (4) Pete Petersen said were near his house  
like many others, I also saw the Hairy Redpoll and female  
White-winged crossbill in C.R./Marion.
