people, peak - H on 19 April - ISU, also one at Ingham Lake, Emmet Co., 9 April - JD

Horned Grebe - 2 on 4 April at Little Wall - ISU, common after that with 40 seen on 19 April - ISU;
one as late as 22 April in Marshall Co. - ISU. seemed more common this year

White Pelican - 11 at Little Wall - 8 April - ISU, gone next day

Double-crested Cormorant - 1 on 9 April at Ingham Lake, Emmet Co., - JD
50 on Des Moines River by Luther, (S of Boone) 9 May - ISU

Great Blue Heron - early 23 March - Ames - ISU

Great Egret - none reported locally

Green Heron - 1st record 11 May - Ames - ISU

Black-crowned Night Heron - 1 seen at Anderson Lake week of 15 May

Geese - Canada first on 22 March near Big Creek, Polk Co - ISU, large migration over Ames on
30 March - ISU

White-fronted - 2 at Anderson Lake on 3 April - ISU

Snow - generally scarce in central Iowa this spring - 500 at Ledges State Park - 26 March - ISU
500 as late as 25 April in Story Co - ISU.

Ducks - a fairly good year although the late open water delayed migration very few birds before
week of # 3 April when virtually all species were present at Little Wall & Anderson Lakes - ISU

The best find was a Breeding Scap seen on 7 April at Little Wall Lake. Mark Ryan
flushed and seen well

Otherwise saw all the species you expect in central Iowa in fair numbers

Warblers - basically a good warbler year with about 25 species seen locally. In general it was a late year. The first Yellow-rumped was seen 16 April but few warblers were seen by 1 May and the peak seemed to come the week of 8 May when virtually all the species were around. Some highlights

Chipping 17 April - Amer, IJU earliest - IJU, common after that

Clay-colored 13 April, Amer - IJU - only report

Field lark 16 April - Amer - IJU, several reported thereafter

Harris' east 4 April, Amer, IJU, some still around until 10 May but not very abundant this year - IJU

White-throated 21 April, Amer IJU - first record, fairly common through mid May but not a big year for them

White-crowned earliest 10 May, Amer, - IJU only, other record was 12 May seemed rarer than usual this spring

Fox sparrow 26 March, fair number for next two weeks - IJU

Lincoln 15 April, Amer - IJU, first record, many reports in first half of May

Swamp 11 April - first, Amer, - IJU, several reported thereafter
