Common Loon (5) in summer plumage were at NORTH TWIN LAKE CALHOUN COUNTY ON 4-15-79 at 6:30 P.M.

pied-billed Grebe - (35) were seen between 4-1-79 and end of period

white-pelican - 25 at Lake Panorama 4-15-79, 60 at Storm Lake 4-28-79 and 60 at Sunk Cove Varina, Iowa 4-30-79.

Double-crested Cormorants - (30) Lake Panorama 4-15-79 (43) STORM LAKE, STORM LAKE, Iowa 4-28-79

Great Blue Heron - ONLY (12) were sighted between 4-1-79 and May-28-79

Green Heron - (2) Pocahontas, Iowa 5-10-79, (2) Boone River, Webster City, Iowa 5-19-79, (1) Little Sioux River Cherokee, Iowa 5-27-79

Great Egret - (2) 4-27-79 were on the Des Moines River at Bradgate, Iowa

Black-crowned Night Heron - (1) Bradgate Conservation Area Bradgate, Iowa 4-27-79

(18) Little Clear lake Laurens, Iowa 4-30-79.

American Bittern - (1) Little Clear Lake Laurens, Iowa 4-30-79

Canada Goose (6) flew over Pocahontas on 3-17-79 and (1) was at Sunken Grove Varina, Iowa on 4-16-77 THIS was all the geese seen during period 3-1-79 to 5-28-79 in Pocahontas County. Apparently the geese held south during the harsh march weather and then quickly over flew Pocahontas County.

Snow + Blue Goose - none Pocahontas County during period. 75,000 Snows and 25,000 Blues were feeding in fields surround Desota Bends National Wildlife Refuge. on 3-24-79

White-fronted Geese - none Pocahontas County (3) 3-24-79 at Desota Bends.

Mallards - Mallard migration peaked 4-8-79 Pocahontas County with 1,154 at LIZARD Lake, Gilmore City, Iowa (small breeding pop. remains at end of period.

Wood Ducks (21) wood ducks were seen Pocahontas County between 4-8 + 4-27-79, (breeding pop. remains at end of period little clearly peaked)

American Widgeons - Widgeon migration<sup>^</sup> at 98 Sunken Grove + Little Clear Lake on 4-13-79 (1) was at a farm puddle 7mi south of Lauren on 5-8-79.

Gadwalls - Gadwall peaked at 50 on Lizard Lake on 4-13-79 for Pocahontas County

Greenwinged Teal - (12) Greenwings were seen between 4-8-79 + 4-30-79 peaking on 4-9-79 at Sunken Grove fr. P.C.

Black Duck (1) middle Coon River at Panora, Iowa 4-10-79

Pintail (500) at Desota Bends 3-24-79 (39) were seen between 4-8-79 + 5-8-79 peaking at 10 on 4-30 at Sunken Grove

Blue-winged Teal - bluemins peaked at 268 on 4-30-79 on a farm puddle 7 miles south of Laurens, Iowa (common BREEDER P.C.)

Northern Shoveler - shovellers peaked pocahontas County at 50 on Sunken Grove on 4-13-79. 3 still present Little Clear L. 6-3-79

Canvasbacks peaked at 382 on 4-13-79 at Little Clear + Sunken Core.

Redheads peaked at 34 on 4-13-79 at Little Clear & Sunken Grove

(11) was at a farm puddle 7 miles south of Laurens, Iowa on 4-30-79 (5) still present Little Clear Lake 6-3-79

Ring-necked Ducks peaked at 37 on 4-13-79 L.C. + S.G. (2)

— were late at Sweet Marsh Tripoli, Iowa 5-13-79

(11) still present Little Clear Lake 6-3-79

Lesser Scaup - peaked at 1000 on 4-8-79 at Lizard Lake

(4) Little Clear Lake 6-3-79

Bufflehead - peaked at 14 on 4-13-79 at Little Clear & Sunken Grove. (1) was still at a farm puddle south of Laurens, Iowa on 4-30-79

Common Goldeneye (8) were at Lizard Lake on 4-8-79

Hooded Mergansers (3) were on a creek 1mi west of Sunken Grove on 4-13-79 - Hooded Merganser migration was very light in Pocahontas County where as last fall migration was quite heavy.

Red-breasted Mergansers (13) were seen in pocahontas county between 4-13-79 & 4-22-79.

Common Mergansers (75) were Desota Bends 3-24-79 and 24 was the peak for P.C. on 4-13-79 at Sunken Grove + Lizard Little Clear Lake

Fuddy Duck peaked at 16 for pocahontas County on 4-22-79 at Sunken Grove + Little Clear Lake. (11) at Desota Bends on 3-24-79 was somewhat early.

Turkey Vulture (1) 4-16-79 Sunken Grove, Varina, Iowa

Osprey (1) 4-9-79 Sunken Grove Varina, Iowa

Bald Eagle (21) Desota Bends National Wildlife Refuge 3-24-79

Northern Harrier (4) Pocahontas County between 3-17-79 and 4-13-79

Sharp-shinned Hawk (1) Sunken Grove Varina, Iowa 4-9-79

Red-tailed Hawk (14) Pocahontas County 4-8-79 and 5-7-79 peaked at 5 at sunken Grove Varina, Iowa on 4-9-79

Broad-winged Hawk (3) Pocahontas on 5-9-79 - 50 were to me by Paul Allen as being at the Pomory Cemetery on 5-1-79

Rough-legged Hawk - (3) at Desota Bends National Wildlife Refuge on 3-24-79. (1) 7mi west of Pocahontas, Iowa on 4-30-79 was unusually late.

American Kestrel 66 between 3-11-79 - 4-29-79 with the peak being 9 on trip to Ligard lake Gilmore City, Iowa

Ring-necked Pheasant - Population P.C. is study to increase

Gray-Partridge - study but down slightly from what seemed to be a peak in 1977.

Upland Sandpiper (2) were present in an alfalfa field 3mi west of Bradgate, Iowa on 4-27-79.

American Woodcock (1) Sunken Grove Vains, Iowa 4-13-79

Wilson's Snipe - (9) were seen in Pocahontas County between 4-8-79 and 4-30-79.

Short-billed Dowitcher - (1) was present May 1 1979 and (60) were present 5-8-79 7mi south of Laurens, Iowa on a farm puddle

Pectoral Sandpiper - (130) were seen P.C. between 4-30-79 and 5-8-79

Dunlin - (1) on 4-30-79 and (21) 5-1-79 south of Laurens, Iowa
