1. White pelicans - small flock at Nashua April 22 - also one remaining at Sweet Marsh May 26. **Life**
2. Black-crowned night heron - 2 at Sweet Marsh May 13

do. 3. Meslin - Sweet Marsh April 22

4. Yellow rail - Sweet Marsh May 26

no.! 5. Upland sandpiper - up to 16 at Mack Sand Prairie on April 28

6. Willets - 2 in flooded field north of Hudson April 28

7. Dunlin - May 12 at Nashua - 1 bird

8. Sanderlings - 2 on May 12 at Nashua

9. Long-eared owl - 1 still at George Wyth State Park on April 29

10. we had an excellent warbler migration with the top bird of my 26 sp being a Connecticut at Sweet Marsh on May 13.
