

FIELD REPORT

SUMMER 1979

Broad-winged Hawk--One at Wapsipinicon State Park, Jones Co., June 6. One at Union Grove State Park, Tama Co., June 11.

American Kestrel--After seeing first hand two-thirds of Iowa this summer the best population of this species is definitely in northeast Iowa.

Common Gallinule--Two were found at Cardinal Marsh, Winneshiek Co., June 17.

Upland Sandpiper--The best populations of this species were in the pastuelands of south central and northeast, where as many as five could be found a day.

White-rumped Sandpiper--Two were found at Rock Creek State Park June 10.

Ring-billed Gull--Two were at Le Grande, Tama Co., June 9.

Belted Kingfisher--Scarce state-wide.

Pileated Woodpecker--Two were found in Shimek Forest, Lee Co. June 1.

Acadian Flycatcher--Four were found at Wapsipinicon State Park, Jones Co., June 6.

Alder Flycatcher--One was found at Shimek State Forest June 2, one was also at Union Grove State Park, June 11.

Least Flycatcher--One was found at Volga Lake July 7 & 22.

Olive-sided Flycatcher--One at Union Grove State Park, June 11.

Veery--Two at Wapsipinicon State Park, June 6.

Loggerhead Shrike--Two immatures were found at Ellsworth, Hamilton Co., June 28.

White-eyed Vireo--One was found at Vinton, Benton Co., June 8.

Black and White Warbler--A singing male was found at Volga Lake July 7.

Worm-eating Warbler--High counts for Lacey-Keosauqua State Park, Van Buren Co., for one day in early June is 2, for Shimek State Forest 4 or more.

Tennessee Warbler--One was in Shimek State Forest, June 1.

Nashville Warbler--A very early migrant was found at Volga Lake July 22.

Parula Warbler--One at Monticello June 5, and one at Wapsipinicon State Park June 6, both in Jones Co., both of the birds were singing males.

Cerulean Warbler--Two at Monticello, June 5, and two at Wapsipinicon S. P. June 6.

Chestnut-sided Warbler--Two singing males were found in Shimek State Forest, June 1, a pair was found at Volga Lake July 7.

Louisiana Waterthrush--Singles were at Wapsipinicon State Park June 6, and Dolliver State Park, Webster Co. June 29.

Morning Warbler--Late migrants were found at Shimek, June 1 and one at Wapsipinicon State Park, June 4.

Hooded Warbler--One at Shimek, June 1 and one at Volga Lake, July 7, both being singing males.
