Dunlin	May 24, '79	2 mi. N & 2 mi. east of Lake Park, Iowa, Dickinson Co.; one bird in flock of Pectoral Sandpipers & other small peeps.
<u>Bell's Vireo</u>	May 26, '79	Kettleson Hogsback Wildlife Area, Spirit Lake, Iowa; three sighted & also verified by two other birders (Greg Anliker & Stan Pugh); <u>first time I've seen these in NW Iowa.</u>
Black-throated Green Warbler	May 26, '79	(location same as above); one male. (verified by names above)
Chestnut-sided Warbler	May 26, '79	(location same as above); two males identified, one female possible but not positive. (verified by names above)
Indigo Bunting	May 26, '79	(location same as above); one male. (verified by names above)
<u>Upland Sandpiper</u>	<u>May 25, '79</u>	<u>Cayler Prairie State Preserve, Dickinson County; calling continuously on area & pair seen in flight.</u>
