Common Snipe - a nest with 4 eggs ~~was~~ found at Hayden Prairie on May 5

Chuck-will's-widow - 1 in Shimek State Forest on May 30 (w/ Joe ~~S.~~ ^{Schaufenbuel})

Acadian Flycatcher - a nest with 2 eggs in Lacy-Keosauqua State Park on May 29

White-eyed Vireo - 1 in YRF on May 4; 1 near Barnes City (Mahaska Co.) on May 25;

1 in Shimek State Forest on May 31 (w/ Joe Schaufenbuel); 1 in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on May 29

Worm-eating Warbler - 8+ individuals in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. and Shimek State Forest

Nashville Warbler ^{May 28 - June 2} (w/ Joe S.)

Northern Parula - 10+ individuals in Von Beuren and Lee Cos. May 28 - June 2 ♀ building nest in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on May 29 (w/ Joe S.)

Blackburnian Warbler - 1 in Shimek S.F. on June 2; 1 in Shimek S.F. on June 3 by Dean Roosa

Yellow-throated Warbler - 4 in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on May 29 (w/ J.S.); 1 in Lee County on June 2

Nashville Warbler - 1 in Shimek S.F. on May 30 (w/ J.S.)

Louisiana Waterthrush - a nest with 2 young in Shimek S.F. on May 24

Hooded Warbler - 1 in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on May 29; 1 in Shimek S.F. on May 31 (w/ J.S.)

Snow Bunting - 2 near Ossian on April 1 (late)
