I would consider the fall migration excellent. Passerines arrived earlier than usual and warblers were present longer and in greater numbers than usual(i.e. 21 sp. of warblers on 23 Aug at Ledges). Shorebird habitat was great at the Saylorville Reservoir and in flooded fields in n. Polk Co. Obviously, the gull concentration at Saylorville was great in late November. I saw 263 species during the fall period.

Merlin- 15 Sep 1986, Ames-female or imm., identified by the falcon profile, small size as compared to a crow, brown streaked underparts, and banded tail.

Merlin- 16 Sep 1986, Ames-female or imm., identified by the small size, long, pointed wings, streaked underparts, and banded tail.

Merlin- 28 Sep 1986, Dunbar Sl.-male, identified by the gray upperparts, falcon profile, banded tail, and light underparts.

Merlin- 3 Oct 1986, Big Creek State Park-female or imm., identified by the small size, falcon profile, long, banded tail, dark back, and heavily streaked underparts.

Merlin- 27 Nov 1986, Saylorville Reservoir-female or imm., identified by the small size, falcon profile, brown streaked underparts, long, banded tail, and brown back.

Peregrine Falcon- 20 Sep 1986, Big Wall L.-ad., identified by the falcon profile, large size(larger than a crow that was harrassing it), light underparts with dark speckling, light underwings, dark gray back, and dark hood.

Peregrine Falcon- 21 Sep 1986, 3 different birds at Saylorville-1 ad. and 2 imm., identified by their large size, falcon profile, and unmarked underwings-the adult had a dark hood, light underparts with dark spotting, and a dark back while the imm. both had light underparts heavily streaked with brown and lighter heads than the adult.

Peregrine Falcon- 28 Sep 1986, near Madrid-ad., identified by the falcon profile, large size as compared to a Rock Dove, dark back and head, and light, unmarked underwings.

Peregrine Falcon- 1 Oct 1986, Ames-ad., identified by the large size as compared to Am. Crows, falcon profile, unmarked underwings, light underparts speckled with brown, and the dark back.

Peregrine Falcon- 3 Oct 1986, Big Creek State Park-ad., identified by the falcon profile, large size, dark hood and back, unmarked underwings, and lighter underparts with dark speckling.

Northern Shrike- 20 Oct 1986, Cooper's M., Story Co.-ad., identified by the larger, more strongly hooked bill, less extensive black mask, white rump, and by its constant tail-pumping.

Black-throated Blue Warbler- 23 Aug 1986, Ledges State Park-male, identified by the bluish back, black throat and sides, white underparts, and white spot on wing.

Black-throated Blue Warbler- 21 Sep 1986, Ledges State Park-male and female-male identified by the blue back, black throat and sides, white underparts, and white spot on wing and female identified by the even brown upperparts, buffy underparts, light eyeline, and white spot on the wing.

Black-throated Blue Warbler- 30 Sep 1986, Brookside Park in Ames-male, identified by the blue back, black throat and flanks, white underparts, and white spot on the wing.
