✓ Roberts' Creek Beach - Red Rock Lake Area
- 2- ✓ Surf Scoter - 1 male Oct. 11.
* West Arm - Badger Creek Lake - Madison County
- 3- Broadwing Hawk - Oct 27. A kettle of 125
✓ observed by many on Des Moines fall census
at Walnut Woods State Park
- 4- Peregrine Falcon - 1 - observed overhead by
✓ several on Des Moines Fall Census - Greenwood Park DM.
- 5- Bobwhite Quail - (erronously reported in summer field
✓ notes, should have read - (one hen quail and thirty
very small chicks)
- 6- ✓ Screech owl - 1 Back at his favorite perch in
the old barn after being absent for the summer.
- 7- ✓ Red-shafted Flicker - coming to our peanut
feeder. Red wing & tail feather shafts - red
whiskers on a grey face.
- 8- ✓ Barn Swallow - late date (Nov. 4) immature
forked tail with white band on underside - dusty orangethroat
- 9- ✓ Rock Wren Nov. 23 seen briefly at the East overlook
at Saylorville Dam
- 10- Le Conte sparrow - 2 flocks of 6 each in Sept.
- 11- sparrows - 13 species seen on Oct. 23rd even
with the white-crowned absent.

12 - goldfinch 40 to 50 coming to our feeders
by mid-November.

13 - Red Crossbills - 7 seen in a Wildlife Area
in NE Madison County.
