- ✓ Buff Breasted Sandpiper - 1 at Saylorville res. 10 Aug.
- ✓ Common Nighthawk - The last at Ames 19 Oct.
- ✓ Chimney Swift - 150 were flying through a sprinkler at Ames 2 Aug.
- ✓ Ruby Throated Hummingbird - 22 at Sweet Marsh 6 Sep.
- ✓ Red Breasted Nuthatch - 1 at Ames 23 Aug.
- ✓ Golden Crowned Kinglet - 45 at Ames 30 Sep.
- ✓ Philadelphia Vireo - 1 at Ledges s.p. 18 Aug.
- ✓ Golden Winged Warbler - 7 at Ledges s.p. 18 Aug.
- ✓ Tennessee Warbler - 1 at Ames 16 Aug.
- Orange Crowned Warbler - see doc.
- ✓ Nashville Warbler - 1 at Ledges s.p. 18 Aug.
- ✓ Chestnut Sided Warbler - first arrivals were 30 at Ledges s.p. 18 Aug.
- ✓ Magnolia Warbler - 1 at Saylorville res. 14 Aug. Peak - 19
on 22 Aug in Polk Co.

- ✓ Cape May Warbler - unusually common: 30 total from 21 Aug - 7 Sep at Ames.
- ✓ Yellow Rumped Warbler - 1 at Ames 24 Aug (imm, photographed)
- ✓ Black Throated Green Warbler - 1 at Ledges s.p. 21 Aug.
- ✓ Bay Breasted Warbler - very common this fall; first were 35 at Ledges s.p. 18 Aug. peak was 42 there 1 Sep.
- ✓ Mourning Warbler - 2 total; 1 at Ames 15 Aug, 1 at Ledges s.p. 18 Aug.
- Wilson's Warbler - uncommon this fall
- ✓ Canada Warbler - first was at Ames 16 Aug, peak was 14 at Ledges s.p. on 18 Aug.
- ✓ White Throated Sparrow - 20 (about) at Geo. Wythe s.p. 6 Sep (100)
- ✓ Eastern Meadowlark - a flock of 20, most of them in song, at Saylorville res. 27 Sep. was odd.
- ✓ Red Crossbill - 2 at Ames 1 Sep., 3 there 30 Oct.
