Ruby Crowned Kinglet	2	Oct. 7-8-9-13 & Nov. 19	In my back yard.
Yellow Rumped Warblers	2	<del>THREE</del> from Oct. 9 thru Oct 31 and still here Nov. 3	These, up to a maximum of 4 birds stayed in my back yard
✓ Northern Junco's	2	Oct. 13	They arrived my back yard this date.
✓ Pine Siskin's	2	Nov 21	First birds this date. Saw them also on Nov. 26 & 29 My back yard, feeders.

September was a very wet month. The Omaha weather bureau reported a total of 6.46" rain, but my rain gauge in Cb showed 7.9 "
