I wrote too soon! I wrote too soon!

On the 15th with temperature at 50 degrees Issaw 25 swan over circling geese - geese who were going down to raft on our !lake". On the water were three stately whistling swan. Don Priebe game warden at Shenandoah, tells me he saw 7 swan at one time and two at two other times at Riverton Refuge. That he has never seen this large a migration before. I believe Don saw the grebe, too, altho I didn't discuss that with him.

On thanksgiving day 165,000 snows were massed at Squaw Creek. Yesterday my friend and I were told there were now 175,000. 25,000 Canada, we only saw two lesser Canadas. My friend cannot do any walking so I stayed in the car with her. Otherwise, we might have seen more on this Refuge. 100 bald eagles there that day and one immature golden. Here at home I saw two mature goldens fly over, MAXIMMATURE and a beautiful bald eagle on the 24th and an immature golden fly past on Sunday.

Also on Sunday I had a sapsucker which I have not seen in years in our yard. (That is not to say we haven't had one, but I just never have seen one.)
