Following are my observations for summer 1988:

*Red-necked Grebe--adult at Diamond Lake on 28 Apr.
Little Blue Heron--immature at Diamond Lake on 29 Jul.
Green-backed Heron--common this summer, 17 individuals seen at
11 different areas.

Green-winged Teal--1 male at L&D #9 on 4 Jun. Lesser Scaup--1 male at Diamond Lake on 6 Jul.

Turkey Vulture--nest with two young each in Winneshiek and Allamakee Co's.

N. Harrier--1 male in Chickasaw Co. on 15 Jun.

Cooper's Hawk--nest with young in each of Allamakee, Clayton, Van Buren and Winneshiek Co's. Two fledged young at another site in Allamakee Co. on 31 Jul. Another nest in Winneshiek Co. with young lost to predation.

Red-shouldered Hawk--at usual Allamakee Co. sites.

Greater Yellowlegs--1 seen and heard at Cardinal Marsh on 1 Jul. *Sandhill Crane--1 seen and heard at Effigy Mounds N.M. on 8 MAY.

Ruby-throated Hummingbird--Allamakee 10, Clayton 2, Dubuque 2, Van Buren 1, Winneshiek 2.

Yellow-bellied Sapsucker--3 nests with young in Winneshiek Co. Pileated Woodpecker--nest with at least 2 young in White Pine Hollow on 18 Jun.

Least Flycatcher--Allamakee 4, Clayton 2, Dubuque 1, Winneshiek 2. Winter Wren--2 adults feeding at least 3 fledged young in Dubuque Co. on 18 Jun.

Veery--1 at Effigy Mounds, 7 in White Pine Hollow, 3 in Winneshiek Co. White-eyed Vireo--1 in YRF, 1 near Eldon.

Bell's Vireo--12 in Mahaska Co. on 26 Jun, nest with 2 young in Winneshiek Co. on 16 Jun.

Chestnut-sided Warbler -- 1 in Winneshiek Co. on 11 Jun.

Hooded Warbler -- 3 in YRF on 4 Jun.

Yellow-breasted Chat--3 in YRF on 4 Jun, 5 in Mahaska Co. on 26 Jun.
