Topside and back were all dark when in flight and perched. The topside of tail had alternating black and brown stripes going up on tail + were the same size. The underside of the tail was lightish with a dark terminal band. A Beautiful Hawk!
✓ Harlan's Red-tailed Hawk	1	Oct. 21	(adult) - N. of Iowa Falls - (Hardin Co.) Dark chocolate Brown Hawk "kiting" over grassy field being plowed up. Had 2-toned wings with dark underwing coverts and white flight feathers. Had very prominent white streaking on its breast. It landed on the plowed ground 2 or 3 times. Upperside of tail was rustyish to light-brownish looking with a distinctive dark terminal band on upperside. Underside of tail was lightish - very distinctively with a dark-blackish terminal band. A Real Beauty!
