Mourning doves seemed scarce all season  
disappeared early except for the three  
noted in November.

Killdeers very scarce all season no  
large numbers observed this fall.

Bluebirds were seen more frequently  
and in better numbers than at any  
time since I have been keeping notes.

Saw one adult eagle (Bald) flying  
south along the river which was the  
earliest observation date for me.
