Drought continued, but lack of rain produced fantastic seed crops. Weeds plus a few water holes in the creek bed brought the most spectacular migration season in my yard in the eleven years we've been here. 100 species (25 warblers) from 20 August to 20 September. 119 yard species for the period. Shorebird habitat tough but birds were concentrated wherever there were mudflats. Many areas became overly vegetated and had few if any shorebirds. Warm weather through most of October made for pleasant birding. Massive cold front, which began moving our way Thanksgiving weekend, was evident by the build-up of common mergansers and goldeneyes and movement of gulls during the day of 25 November.
