12-15 Canada Geese (below Coralville Reservoir Dam.)

18 12 Robins

March 13

7 Saw-whet owls in small clump of cedars - Had them (one to 3) all winter - (on Coal Road - north of River)

First big wave of ducks (2 weeks late) mostly mallards & pintails  
(but 40 canvasback & some others)

Winter population at minimum level, with no northern types -

normal population of hawks - red-tails, rough legs & marsh -

long-eared & short-eared owls only in single locations - (4 to 10 birds.)

~~Reports of few birds at bird feeders - a few Purple Finches -~~

~~Severe cold in early Dec. sent birds south?~~
