Nothing very unusual
to report I did not see as many
warblers as last year and the
robin flight did not seem as heavy
although I may have missed some
of it. On Sept 25 saw about 45
jays flying high and south.

Saw a yellow-billed Cuckoo Oct
22nd. Thought it rather a late date.

Incidentally earlier in Oct. saw a yellow-
billed Cuckoo catch and eat a Monarch
butterfly. It had a bit of trouble
getting it down but it managed.

The Evening Grosbeaks mentioned
in the report were not seen again. They
were feeding on Sumac berries and on
the ground where apples and mulberries
had fallen and rotted.
