Snow Goose--1 immature summered in Poweshiek Co.

Bald Eagle--1 subadult on 4 Jun in Winneshiek CO.

N. Harrier--1 adult on 11 Jul near New Hampton.

Cooper's Hawk--3 nests in Winneshiek Co. produced at least 8 young.

Swainson's Hawk--2 on 29 Jun near Bluffton.

Yellow-bellied Sapsucker--nest with young on 14 Jun near Decorah
and 15 Jun at Luster Heights.

Alder Flycatcher--1 on 14 Jun near Decoarh.

Least Flycatcher--1 on 14 Jun near Highlandville, 1 on 29 Jun
near Decorah.

Brown Creeper--1 on 27 Jun at Sny Magill, 1 on 28 Jun at Effigy Mounds.

Winter Wren--2 on 27 Jun at White Pine Hollow.

Veery--4 on 13 Jun in Brush Creek Canyon, 1-4 also found in Yellow
River Forest, White Pine Hollow and 2 areas in Winneshiek Co.

N. Mockingbird--1 on 7 Jul in Poweshiek Co.

White-eyed Vireo--1 on 15 Jun at Sny Magill.

Chestnut-sided Warbler--1 on 29 Jun near Bluffton, 1 all summer
in Yellow River Forest

Magnolia Warbler--1 on 16 Jun in Yellow River Forest.

Hooded Warbler--2 on 16 Jun in Yellow River Forest.

Yellow-breasted Chat--4 all summer at Lake Hawthorn, Mahaska Co.

House Finch--1-3 all summer in Decorah, Grinnell and Montezuma.
