

Dear Jim,

I have two more bird reports for you. On 6 July, I got two very close looks at a hawk about 2 miles north of Cayler Prairie. After weighing all the field marks from the sitting and flying views, I feel that it was an immature Ferruginous Hawk. The only other possibility was a Kreider's Red-tail, but I saw the bird with binoculars facing me at about 25 yards twice, and it matches the picture in the field guides.

We also saw two Lesser Yellowlegs at Kettleston Hogsback on 7 July.
