May 31 Whippoorwill nest & 2 eggs

June 5, 9, 26. King Rail in same area

" 5 White-rumped Sandpipers (40)

" 24 a Carolina Wren (first in several years)

" 26 2 Ring-billed Gulls (Reservoir)

July 3 First Short-billed Wren (and more since)

" 5 Family of Chats north of Calamus (Esther Copp) Vane & I went over and saw them

" 24 Solitary Sandpipers (2), Pectoral (1), Lesser Yellowlegs (2)

Aug. 22 Blue-winged Teal (80) Swan Lake,

also several families of Wood Ducks raised there.
