✓ G. Egret - 1st on 3/28 <sup>than last year</sup>  
Canada Goose - on 5/31 35 gosling with 6 adults were present on the mudflats north of Jester, in one large flock.  
G.W. Teal - 141 on 3/14  
Widgeon - 217 on 3/28  
✓ S. Shoveler - 267 had gathered by 4/19, most on the pond at La Public TV in Johnston  
- R. B. Merganser - 276 on 3/29  
✓ B. Eagle - max of 61 on 3/14  
Piping Plover - 1 on 4/19, and 5/5 at Sandpiper Beach where it is regular in the spring  
Willet - 21 on 5/2  
Upland S.P. - 1st on 4/29 at Moeckly Prairie  
H. Godwit - 1 on 5/3  
✓ R. Turnstone - 1 on 5/17 and 2 on 5/23  
✓ Sandpiper - 2 on 4/19, 1 on ~~5/3~~ 5/3, 5/16
