Enclosed is my first Winter Bird Population Study. I am not including a map and description of the place as I forwarded that to you at an earlier date. In my daily report to you I tried (sometimes I goofed) to list the birds in the order of the Iowa Ornithologists' Field Checking List, and not in order of decreasing abundance, species of the same abundance in taxonomic order. In the total count I did the latter and averaged the number of individuals per trip rounded to the nearest whole number. Do you prefer some other way?

I made up a report for Mr. Haven Kolb, Hereford High School, Parkton, Maryland, 21120, which I am enclosing. Would you please, if you possibly could, take a quick look and see if you think it is alright to send, and if so, forward it to him? I tried to follow the procedure as described in his reprint "AUDUBON FIELD NOTES", June 1965, pp. 432-434. It proved more time-consuming than I had anticipated.

So many new birds are returning that I am getting lost trying to identify them. Up to deer hunting season we had bobwhite, but only once did I hear or see one in your report. However, there is a nice big covey of them nesting in the gully close to the middle spring now.
