Chimney swift - late date 3 seen over my office on 10/31 and 1 on the next day on 11/1.

Olwe sided flycatcher - 8/10 9/7

Yellow throated vireo - 8/10 - 8/19

solitary vireo - one individual seen outside my office window on 11/14 - latest date I have heard of.

Warblers - 22 species seen week of 9/1-9/9 including Canada, cerulean, cape may (1), golden winged, ovenbird and Parula (9/21),

and Prairie Warbler seen on 9/7 at Croton unit Shenck Forest.

Tanager - Scarlet - seen 9/7, 10/5

Tanager, Summer - 9/9 (1) Croton unit Shenck

Chipping Sparrow - several dozen in Aspen Grove Cemetery on 11/7 and 11/8

Sharp-tailed Sparrow - 9/28 - up to 6 at Cone Marsh

Le Conte's Sparrow - 10/5 - 10/6 grassy field/ditch N. of Burlington

Layland Longspur - flock of 20-30 - Green Bay Bottoms field - Lee County. 11/17

Snow Bunting - up to 6 with flock of Longspurs in Green Bay Bottoms - Lee Cty 11/17

Rusty Blackbird - 11/17 - D. Moines Cty 50 or so with flock of redwings - Iowa Southern Utility Plant S. of Burlington.

Eurasian Tree Sparrow - well established N of Burlington with a flock of 30-40 individuals in fence row next to Dumb-bell Lake on 10/5

Top Sightings 8/1 - 11/30

Common Loon - several sightings including 2 at Lake Seede on 11/17

Horned Grebe - 1 in Miss. River at Montrose on 11/2 and 2 (winter plumage) at Seede on 11/17

White Pelican - we don't get many pelicans but had singles on 8/3 and 10/9 6 on 10/11

Great Egret - 20 still remained in Iowa River backwater at Wapello, 1 seen on 10/23

Black Crowned N. Heron - seen on several occasions at Casey Barrow - 8/3 and 8/5

Mute Swan - 2 seen at Casey-Barrow on 10/9

Osprey - regular along river at Casey Barrow and Seede. 8/28 - 9/2 - 9/7

N. Goshawk - 1 along Bluff H. way 99 N of Burlington 10/30

Peregrine - 1 over office on 11/8

Gray Partridge - seen regularly as they are established in N. Res. marsh East of Highway 99.

Sora - 1 on 10/5

Black bellied plover - singles seen 9/21, 9/26 and 10/19 at

Casey Barrow

Golden plover - small flock of 6 seen Casey Barrow on 9/2

Ruddy Turnstone - singles seen on 8/28 9/7 Casey Barrow

Sanderlings - seen on 8/28, 9/2, 9/21, 9/26 with 6 seen on 9/21 at Casey Barrow

Franklin's Gull - seen from 9/26 with 1 individual through 11/2 with 2 individuals.

Bonaparte's Gull - up to 100 seen on 11/2 in Miss. R at Montrose - 2 seen 11/16

Common Tern - 2 seen on 8/10 at Casey Barrow
