Sorry I'm a few days late with my fall report. I was reviewing Family Practice Residency training grants in Washington DC, and just got home.

It has not been a particularly good fall at Saylorville. Duck numbers have been very low, as have been gulls. I think in part due to a low number of shad in the lake. All reports are from Saylorville area unless otherwise noted.

C. Loon - 1st on 10/17, max. of 5 on 11/7, lost on 11/29 at Mottett

✓ H. Gobe - 2 on 11/7

✓ Western Gobe - 2 were present on 11/14

✓ W. Pelican - Max of 2035 on 8/15 - lost on 11/1

Cormorant - 1st on 8/8; max of 644 on 10/10

B.C. Night Heron - 1 in 9/7

✓ W.F. Goose - Max of 154 on 10/17

Mallard - max number very small, probably 3000

✓ Canvasback - max of 64 on 11/7

✓ Black S. Star - 1 appeared on 11/19, a female, with white cheek, no knob on bill. IPTV pond in Johnston

✓ Bufflehead - Max. of 71 on 11/18 at IPTV pond

✓ Hooded Merganser - Max. of 58 on 11/7

✓ C. Merg. - Max of 1800 on 11/29

✓ Ruddy Duck - max of 23 on 11/7

✓ Osprey - 1st on 8/15

B. Eagle - 1st on 10/31, max only 12 - most seemed to be at Red Rock

- ~~✓~~ Coot - max of 3250 on 10/17
- ~~✓~~ Sandpiper - 1 ft on 8/2, Max of 8 on 9/6
- ~~✓~~ Baird's Sandpiper - last on 11/16, on Sandpiper, with long wings, black legs
- ~~✓~~ Pectoral S'p'r - max. of 235 on 8/2,
- ~~✓~~ Stilt S'p'r - max. of 30 on 9/6
- ~~✓~~ Buff-breasted S'p'r - 2 on 8/2 were a bit early at Sandpiper
- ~~✓~~ Piping plover - 1 appeared on 8/21; this bird appears to be regular at Sandpiper Beach, appearing in 5 of the last 6 years (2 Springs, 4 Falls on my records alone)
- ~~✓~~ R.B. Gull - at least 50 were present throughout summer, all immature
- ~~✓~~ Herring Gull - 1st on 10/17
- ~~✓~~ Franklin's Gull - max of 10,000 on 10/3
- ~~✓~~ Bonaparte's Gull - 1st on 10/3, max of only 23 on 11/18
- Carolina Wren - one was in our yard from summer, into fall, last seen 11/7 when I moved its roost (a hanging plant on the porch) into the house
- Sedge Wren - max of 18 on 8/15, last on 10/3
- ~~✓~~ Dicit - max of 73 on 10/3
- ~~✓~~ L. Shrike - 1 on 8/30
- ~~✓~~ Cedar Waxwings - seemed abundant in the period, max of 252 on 11/1
- Warblers - seemed very sparse, - specially compared to last fall
- ~~✓~~ Golden-winged Warbler - 1 on 9/6
- ~~✓~~ Sharp-tailed Sparrow - one was in an unusual location, in a marshy area near Sandpiper on 10/3. Observed at 10-15 yds. Grey crown easily seen (not white of Leconte's), larger size; ochre face, gray check.
