Thanks for you excellent fall field report. You found a lot of good stuff. I have few questions about dates and locations.

--need specific dates and locations for Canada, Cerulean, Cape May, and Golden-winged warblers.

--need location for Scarlet Tanager on 5 Oct.

--what is official name for Casey-Barrow (Access?)

--location for Sora on 5 Oct.

--location for Franklin's Gull on 2 Nov.

--need details of identification for Common Tern.

--location for Indigo Bunting on 5 Oct.

--should House Wren be 10/5 rather than 5/10, location?

In general, we need date, location and number of birds for each sighting that we cite. It is also helpful to have county for locations that are not commonly used in IBL Field Reports, e.g. Geode.

Enclosed are some form sheets that many people use for their reports. They aren't required, but are helpful.

Your report is particularly useful, since we don't get much data from the SE corner of the state. I hope you will be a regular contributor.
