Interesting is the only word that comes to mind in describing this fall. The number of extralimital species has been incredible, but some of the more common fall migrants have been difficult to find. As in the spring, shorebirds seemed to nearly by-pass Iowa and, even with an abundance of habitat, small numbers were obvious. Warbler and vireo migration was excellent with large numbers of Red-eyed Vireos noted. Usual locations for sparrows and pipits were devoid of vegetation and consequently were devoid of birds. The long-lasting flood waters certainly took a toll on the abundance of natural foods in the flood plains. Although there was a shortage of many common species, the unusual were prizes for the season. These included Reddish Egret, Laughing Gull, Sabine's Gull, Ross' Gull, and Red-necked Grebe.
