After a wet summer the fall season was quite dry. The warbler migration was quite good. The Grammer Grove outing presented a remarkable diversity of warblers. I presume these will be reported by others and therefore I'll not report them. Some general observations:

The number of Red-breasted Nuthatches in Lamb's Grove is definitely up from previous years. In fact, I have been having more Red-breasted Nuthatches at my feeder than White-breasted Nuthatches!

Though I have had House finches at my feeder, the numbers so far are down from last year.

Also many Black-throated Green Warblers migrated through this fall.
