Greater White-Fronted Goose	3/5/94	Swan Lake State Park, Carroll County	10 birds with early arriving Canada & Snow Geese
Osprey	4/24/94	Grant Park, Sac County	2 osprey perched in dead tree, left chasing each other & returned in few minutes
Turkey Vulture	3/30/94	Grant Park, Sac County	First ones of spring for me
Tree Swallow	4/29/94	Dayton Oaks Church Camp, Webster County	10 huddled together on very chilly morning on fence-line
House Wren	4/20/94	Grant Park, Sac County	Heard & then saw my first of season
Blue-Gray Gnatcatcher	4/20/94	Grant Park, Sac County	I was first drawn by its thin, wheezy song and then located the bird, with white eye-ring and long tail, as its moved around the trees
Northern Waterthrush	5/2/94	Lake View, Sac County	Found two in small wet patch of woods near Black Hawk Lake
White-Eyed Vireo	5/3/94	University 40 Park, Calhoun County	Identified by white eyes, wing bars, yellowish "glasses," pale throat
Yellow-Headed Blackbird	4/18/94	University 40 Park, Calhoun County	Yellow-head and white wing patches drew attention to my first of the season
