Field reports-fall 1994

Pacific Loon-one at Anderson Lake, 16 September (the day before the early duck seasons started), I did not see it there when I revisited the area in early October

Eared Grebe--2 at Grovers Lake, 16 August

American White Pelican--500 at Mud Lake, 16 August

Ibis species - one at Tomahawk Marsh, Sac Co. 10, 11 Oct, seen by Mike Mahn and Larry Kropf, Ia DNR, details-curved bill, size, brown plumage, wading in marsh and probing around muskrat houses

four ibis species flew over Eagle Lake, Hancock Co., 19 Sept, seen by Guy Zennor, Ia DNR, fide JJD (details)

Canvasback-brood at Mud Lake, Clay Co. in August, seen by Jennifer Sells (fide JJD)

White-winged Scoter-2 at Red Rock, 29 Oct (large all dark duck, heavy bill, white wing patch seen clearly in flight), JJD, SD

Bonaparte's Gull-225 at Big Creek L. on 10 Nov

Black Tern-two at Blackhawk Lake, 16 September

Herring Gull--one immature at north end of Spirit L., 16 August

Little Gull-one at Big Creek Lake, 14 November 1994 (see documentation)

Common Black-headed Gull-one at Big Creek Lake, 23 Nov 1994 (see documentation)

Short-eared Owl-about 10-12 flushed in field near Chariton, Lucas Co., 23 Nov (Brent Danielson fide JJD)

Chimney Swift-1000 entering roost in Ames, 5 September

Red-breasted Nuthatch-one in Ames, 18 September

White-throated Sparrow-one in Ames, 17 September
