At the same location I had up to 3 singing Cerulean Warblers on 7, 11, and 15 June. I saw the male Prothonotary there on the same dates. There was a male Scarlet Tanager there on 7 June.

I am planning to submit a short note for IBL on an unusual Barred Owl vocalization I heard in Iowa City in June. More later.

I am already very busy in my medical practice. We're still in boxes at our new house. Yard birds so far include Chuck-will's-widow, Bewick's Wren, and Scissor-tailed Flycatcher. Daniel and I went to the upper coast our first weekend back. It was nice to see that Brown Pelican has repopulated the area in my absence. We saw all the expected waders and shorebirds, an unexpected Masked Booby, gallinules and moorhens with chicks, Anhingas, White-tailed Kites,
