Sandhill Cranes - seen before dawn heard fly over us at about 200m. Established breeder at Green Island.

Marbled Godwit - at Coon's lake. (5 miles, Elk River Jct. on Miss. R.) - range 500m. - brown, very long, slightly upturned bill, size of weakly teal. (body)

Wh-rumped Sandpiper - Coon Marsh - entirely white rump seen in flight.

Baird's Sandpiper - 7 cities, 50m. smaller than Federal sips, dark legs, + bill, wide feather edges on back. 100m.

Short-billed Dowitcher - 30X scope. rump 50m. tan below, evenly colored. 5 spotted. Darker than tan feathered. 20m - 30-35X scope.

Common Tern - Loch 14 - wings dark at tips - 150m - present on frontier a week - 30X scope per bridges.

Chuck-will's-widow - calling at regular nest site - BSMNP early evening.

Alder Flycatcher - we-bee-o-call clearly heard - bird fighting with another. *Campidoux - Pr. Marsh W. & winter Wren - woods NW of Sabula - 30- very small, rich brown, very short tail.*

Black-throated Blue Warbler - seen *at Green Island - levee near Brown's lake. Blue back, black sides, white belly - 25m. buzzy call - "I am so laaaa"*

Sharp-tailed Sparrow - heard at west end of Green Island - just before dawn heard only - buzzy trill, low note at end. played tape for comparison just after.

Harris Sparrow - regular in E. Iowa this year - large black cap throat, wing bars, pink bill - 5.05 Fall peck Rd, Louisiana - increase 5/11.

Eurasian Tree Sparrow - at usual Sampson Ave loc - Muscotine - brown cap, bl. spots on cheek, small bib.
