- Red-breasted Nuthatch 5/8/94 Iowa City, Johnson Co.
last at my feeder . May have been
migrant rather than the bird that
wintered here as this bird was seen for
about 7 days, preceded by a 2 week
stretch with no Red-breasted Nuthatch
sightings.
- Loggerhead Shrike 4/23/94 near Cone Marsh, Louisa Co
perhaps breeding: 1] bird seemed to be
partial to this local and did not go very
far and 2] Shrike sp seen at same
location by IOU Field Trip (not by me)
on 4/9.
- Mourning Warbler 5/18/94 UI Campus, Iowa City, Johnson Co.
Location not totally far-fetched as in
ravine between ML, BSB and Quad Dorm.

Field Notes for Mourning Warbler:

Head, Throat and upper back were gray, giving a hooded look.

No white anywhere on head or around eyes.

Belly & breast yellow, back olive.

Brief look in Good Light (full sunlight and shade) at 20' with 7x35.

Bird Silent and disappeared into undergrowth.
