Yellow Billed Cuckoo - 1 - June 1 - heard it calling along
Indian Creek in the NW part of Cass County.

Bobolinks - 3 Males - June 13 - had been seeing males
from June 11 to June 26 - ^{the most was on the 13th.} on a Blue Grass
pasture on farm in NW Cass County

Orchard Oriole - 2 (Male & Female) - June 24 - Saw the ~~first~~
first year male ^(first) on June 10, almost ^{every} day until
July 6. He was hanging around the Mulberry
grove. Finally I spotted the ^{yellowish} nest & a female -
~~they~~ ~~were~~ ~~in~~ the top of a small ash tree
which was in the mulberry grove. ^{It was higher than the} ~~mulberry~~ ~~tree.~~
The first year male is a Champagne green with a
black bib. Mrs. Oriole is the same - didn't have
the bib. Mr. Oriole spent most of his ~~time~~ ^{day} -
singing. ~~all day~~ He usually sat in the open -
where he could watch the going on. And a
pair of King birds had a nest close by in the
top of Evergreen. This was on a farm yard in
NW Cass County. Hope they come back again
next year.
