Some items re spring migration -
I trust Woody Brown sent his report,
so I won't repeat.

Warm-eating Warbler - banded one
May 23 - Pine Hill Cem - 1st banded
in 12 years there.

Warbler movements - pretty practically
only a trickle - somewhat of a wave

May 22 + June 2, the latter also
strong on thrushes + empidonax flycatcher,
especially yellow-bellied.

Yellow-crud. Night Heron - Dan - 5/30.
Total warbler banding for May
down to only about 30% of average,
Green + Nashville especially down - only
one Nashville.

Leaving for Trinidad tomorrow.
