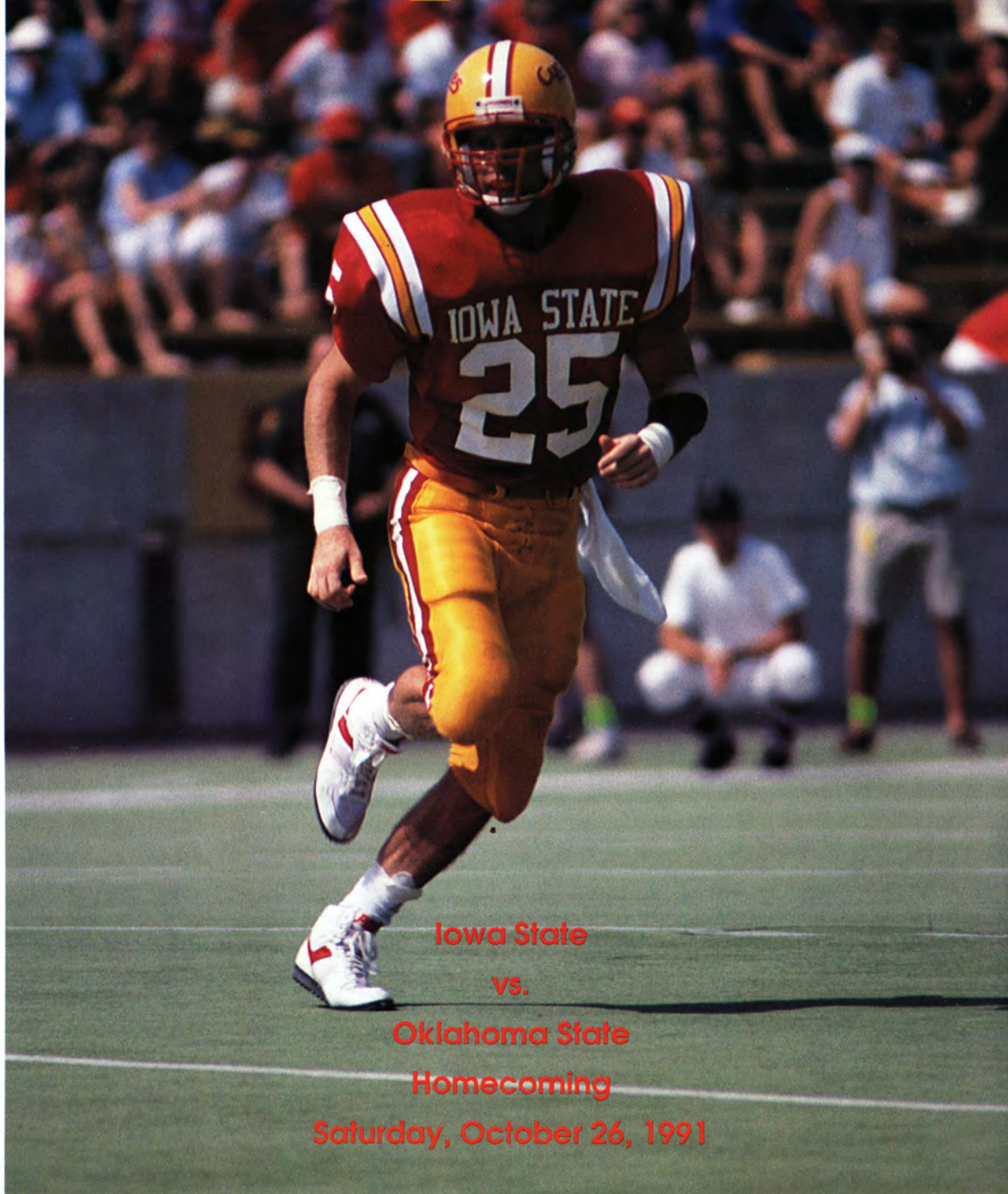

Since the first students enrolled at Iowa State, the institution has been committed to academic excellence. Iowa State's reputation for scholarship is internationally known and Iowa State's students are respected nationwide as serious scholars.

Iowa State University was founded in 1858 under terms of the Land Grant College Act signed by President Abraham Lincoln during the Civil War. Since the beginning, Iowa State has been a co-educational "people's college."

As years passed, the University developed a reputation as an outstanding broad-based institution with academic emphasis in the humanities and the arts, while maintaining its position in the scientific and technical fields. Recently, Iowa State has become known as a leading research center, renowned in the fields of engineering and agriculture.

One of the largest institutions governed by the State Board of Regents, Iowa State is a major Midwestern center of learning for more than 25,000 students, from all 50 states and more than 100 other nations. Iowa State attracts a diverse student body with a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs with a student to teaching faculty ration of 18. More than 120 undergraduate programs of study are available from Iowa State's eight colleges: Agriculture, Business Administration, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences, Liberal Arts and Sciences and Veterinary Medicine.

The picturesque campus is comfortably situated in a central campus "park" - a splendid combination of conventional and contemporary architecture. ISU's classrooms and buildings are a blend of the old and then new, nestled amid thousands of trees and acres of greenery. The ultra-modern south campus is dominated by the Iowa State Center, Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field, and the College of Veterinary Medicine.

The Iowa State Center, which boasts one of the nation's finest facilities of its kind, consists of the C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, the J.W. Fisher Theater, the

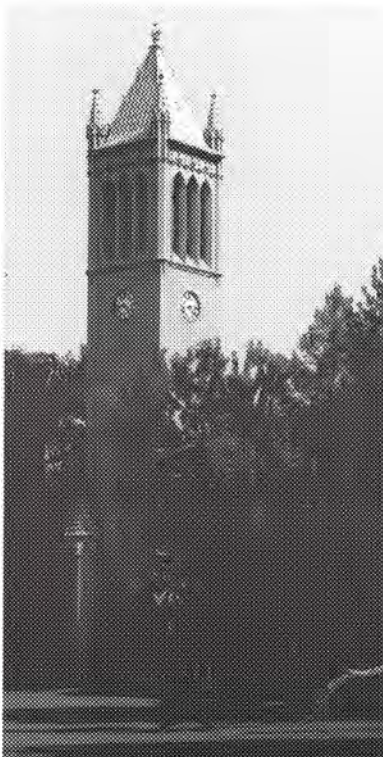
Scheman Continuing Education Center, and the James H. Hilton Coliseum. Concert facilities draw some of the top names in entertainment. Bruce Springsteen, Tina Turner, Bill Cosby, the Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, Billy Joel, and the Broadway hit "Cats" have been featured on campus.

One of the highlights of the year occurs in spring as the campus blooms with tulips and apple blossoms just in time for the Veishea celebration. "Veishea" is ISU's annual open house and the largest student-run festival in the nation, complete with parade, exhibits and thousands of alumni. The campus is also breathtaking sight in the fall, when autumn colors and leaves make it a cardinal and gold show place.

Sports are a vital part of the life at Iowa State, as the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics offers 21 men's and women's sports and the extensive intramural program boasts one of the highest student participation rates in the country. A number of Cyclone intercollegiate teams have been nationally ranked in recent years and several have brought home national titles. Iowa State has also produced 24 Olympians, three of whom captured gold medals. While athletics remain in the spotlight, the academic side shares equal time.

The opportunities that Iowa State offers stretch beyond the lengths of academics and athletics. There are ample opportunities for students to participate in theater, music, dance and intramural sports, as well as numerous academic and campus organizations. The Greek system is strong, as are the residence halls. Both have been nationally recognized, along with the top-notch academic advising program.

Iowa State reaches beyond this by offering its students some of the most advanced athletic, cultural and social opportunities in the Midwest.

Cowboys Stand as ISU Homecoming Challenge



As Iowa State plays host to Oklahoma State in this afternoon's Homecoming contest, memories linger of past Cyclone-Cowboy clashes featuring wide-open offenses with big point results. Both teams come into today's game looking to generate some of that offensive prowess.

Iowa State's offense suffered a major blow last week at Kansas, when ISU quarterback Chris Pedersen was forced out of the game with a separated shoulder. With signal-caller Bob Utter in the stands because of injury, the Cyclones were left without an experienced quarterback.

If Utter isn't ready this afternoon, then it could be Kevin Caldwell, Marv Seiler or Ty Yohe at the offensive helm. Caldwell, converted to runningback from quarterback earlier this season, was an honorable mention all-state selection at Millard South High School in Omaha, Neb.

The Iowa State defense continues to present a imposing obstacle to opponent offenses. While Kansas did rack up 41 points, the Jayhawks only generated 299 yards of total offense. Nearly all the KU points came on short drives. The Cyclone defense suffered its share of misfortune last Saturday. Cornerback Andrew Buggs also will miss the balance of this season with a separated shoulder.

It has been tough going for Oklahoma State this season, although against formidable competition. Cowboy opponents have racked up a 27-8-1 (.764) record, one of the toughest schedules nationally. Every team OSU has played this fall still maintains a winning record heading into this afternoon's games.

Oklahoma State-Iowa State games have often been wild affairs. It was a 54-0 victory over OSU in 1971 that sent the Cyclones packing for the Sun Bowl, ISU's first post-season contest. That 1971 squad is in Ames today for a 20-year reunion. Each of the last four Iowa State-Oklahoma State games between ISU head coach Jim Walden and OSU mentor Pat Jones have featured big offensive numbers.

In 1987, a skeleton crew of Cyclones took Gator Bowl-bound Oklahoma State to the wire in Stillwater, Okla. A 26-yard field goal by Jeff Shudak closed the Cowboy lead to 33-27 with 2:43 left in the third quarter. Future Buffalo Bill Thurman Thomas rushed 30 times for a school-record 293 yards and four touchdowns, including two in the game's last five minutes, to secure a 48-27 victory. Joe Henderson led ISU with 25 carries for 137 yards and a touchdown. Cyclone quarterback Brett Sadek closed out his ISU career hitting on 19 of 36 passes for 265 yards and two TD passes to wide receiver Dennis Ross.

In 1988, the Holiday Bowl-bound Cowboys pulled out a win in the game's final 15 minutes in Ames. Iowa State went ahead 28-21 with 14:55 left in the contest when Henderson ended a 16-play, 70-yard drive with a 3-yard touchdown run. Henderson finished with 104 yards on 22 carries. Oklahoma State fought back. Heisman trophy winner Barry Sanders raced 80 yards for a touchdown three plays after Henderson's score. An interception and a fumbled pitch started two more OSU touchdown drives as the Cowboys won 49-28. Sanders rushed for 293 yards on 32 carries.

Iowa State turned the tables in 1989. Blaise Bryant rushed 33 times for 208 yards and two touchdowns to lead Iowa State to a 31-21 win, locking up a winning season. Bryant, who finished the game as ISU's all-time leading single-season rusher, scored on a 4-yard run with 12:59 left in the first quarter. Iowa State led 24-7 with 10:49 left in the third quarter after Bret Oberg scored on a 16-yard run. Iowa State then held off a furious Oklahoma State comeback to finish the season with three straight wins.

Oklahoma State got a boost from the leg of placekicker Cary Blanchard last season in Ames. The All-American booted four field goals as the Cowboys won 25-17.

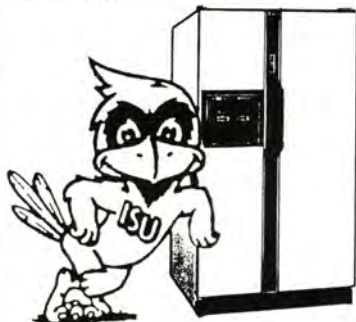

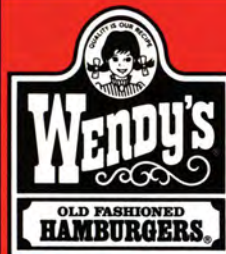

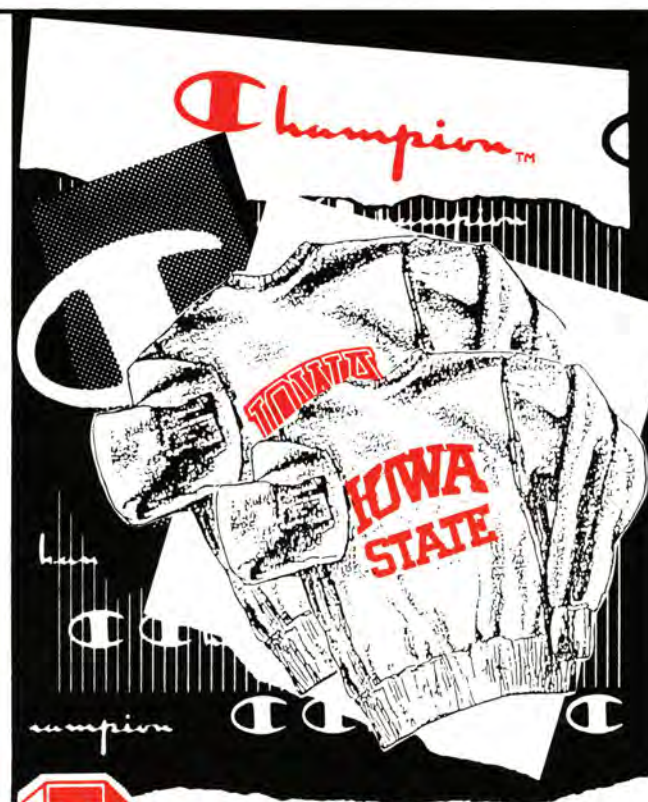

MARTIN C. JISCHKE

President Iowa State University

When Martin Jischke became Iowa State University's 13th president on June 1, 1991, he brought to ISU an impressive record of administrative service and scholarly achievement spanning nearly 25 years.

Before his appointment at ISU, Dr. Jischke served five years as chancellor of the University of Missouri-Rolla. Under his leadership at the UMR, an enrollment decline was reversed, sponsored research increased by 50 percent, the number of private donors doubled, more than \$60 million in new facilities were added to the campus, and a major program

of manufacturing research and technology transfer was initiated.

Dr. Jischke was a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, Norman, for 17 years, serving as dean of the College of Engineering from 1981 to 1986,

interim president in 1985, director and professor of the School of Aerospace, Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering from 1977 to 1981, and professor of aerospace, mechanical and nuclear engineering from 1968 to 1975.

He received the B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from the Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago, and the master's degree in 1964 and the Ph.D.

degree in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and problems related to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft. He was a research fellow for NASA at Moffett Field in the summer of 1973, a research fellow at the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory in the summer of 1971, and a research engineer at the Battelle Northwest Laboratory in the summer of 1970.

Dr. Jischke is the author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications, 21 major technical reports and the co-editor of one book. He has received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health, the National Severe Storms Laboratory and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

From 1975 to 1976, he was a White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation in the U.S. Department of Transportation with a special emphasis in the area of automobile safety. He is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and an Associate Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics. He is listed in "Who's Who in America," "Who's Who in Engineering," "American Men and Women of Science" and "Outstanding Educators of America."

Dr. Jischke and his wife, Patty, have two children, Charles 14, and Mary, 10. Patty Jischke earned the Bachelor of Arts degree in social work in 1970 and the Juris Doctorate in 1971 in 1975 from the University of Oklahoma Bar Association.

IOWA STATE HEAD COACH—JIM WALDEN



early five years ago, Iowa State University began the search for a football coach. The Cyclones were looking for a new direction, a new personality and a new attitude for the Iowa State program. ISU found all of those ingredients in Jim Walden, and on December 16, 1986, the former Washington State mentor became Iowa State's 28th head football coach.

The personable native of Aberdeen, Mississippi arrived at ISU with "no magic formulas," just a promise to "come in here and do the best I can and to work as hard as I know how." Walden proved to be a man of his word, bringing

greater success both on and off the field to each of his Cyclone squads.

His first ISU team finished 3-8-0 and demonstrated consistent improvement throughout the season. His 1988 unit improved to 5-6-0 and challenged for a winning season. The Cyclones finished fifth in the Big Eight Conference.

The third time proved to be a charm. Walden's 1989 squad went 6-5 for the school's first winning season under his direction. ISU's 4-1 road record was its best since 1978. Iowa State ended the year ranked among the nation's top 25 teams in rushing and total offense.

In 1990, Walden guided the Cyclones to fourth-place finish in the Big Eight, a conference that featured national powerhouses Colorado, Oklahoma and Nebraska. ISU also defeated the Sooners for the first time since 1961.

As the head coach at Washington State for nine years, Walden compiled a 44-52-4 record against tough Pacific 10 Conference competition. During that time, Walden guided the Cougars to three winning seasons and four first-division conference finishes.

The 53-year-old Walden was at Washington State for 10 years, first serving as an assistant to Warren Powers. When Powers left WSU following the 1977 season, Walden was tabbed as his replacement and began building the Washington State program. The culmination of a four-

year plan came when Walden took the Cougars to the 1981 Holiday Bowl, WSU's first bowl appearance since the 1931 Rose Bowl. WSU finished the season with an 8-3-1 mark, needing only a win in the regular-season finale to go to the Rose Bowl.

Walden's success did not go unnoticed by his peers. He earned Pac-10 Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1981 and 1983. In 1981, he was the UPI West and AFCA/Kodak District IX Coach-of-the-Year. Following the 1981 season, he was asked to be an assistant coach for the West squad in the Japan Bowl and at the East-West Shrine Game that year. He was the head coach of the victorious West squad in the 1985 East-West Shrine Game, and was an assistant at the 1986 Hula Bowl.

Despite spending 10 years in the Pac-10, Walden came to ISU familiar with Big Eight Conference football. He started his collegiate coaching career in 1969 at Nebraska under his former college coach, Bob Devaney. For the next four seasons, Walden was a defensive coach for the Cornhuskers. During those years Nebraska won two national championships.

From Nebraska, Walden moved to Miami (Fla.) in 1973 as an offensive backfield coach for Pete Elliott, and was later named defensive coordinator under Carl Selmer. Walden joined Powers' Washington State staff as backfield coach for the 1977 season.

As a collegiate quarterback at Wyoming, Walden guided the Cowboys to a pair of Skyline Conference titles. Following his college career, Walden signed with the British Columbia Lions of the Canadian Football League and coached Amory High School in his native Mississippi for five years before going to Nebraska.

An excellent speaker, Walden is in demand for outside engagements. The NCAA has selected him twice as a guest speaker at its annual College Football Preview, in 1983 and 1985. Since coming to ISU, he's become a popular figure with both students and fans in appearances across the state. Since the day he was hired, Jim Walden has proved that he was the "right person" to bring a new direction, new attitude, and new personality to the Iowa State football program.

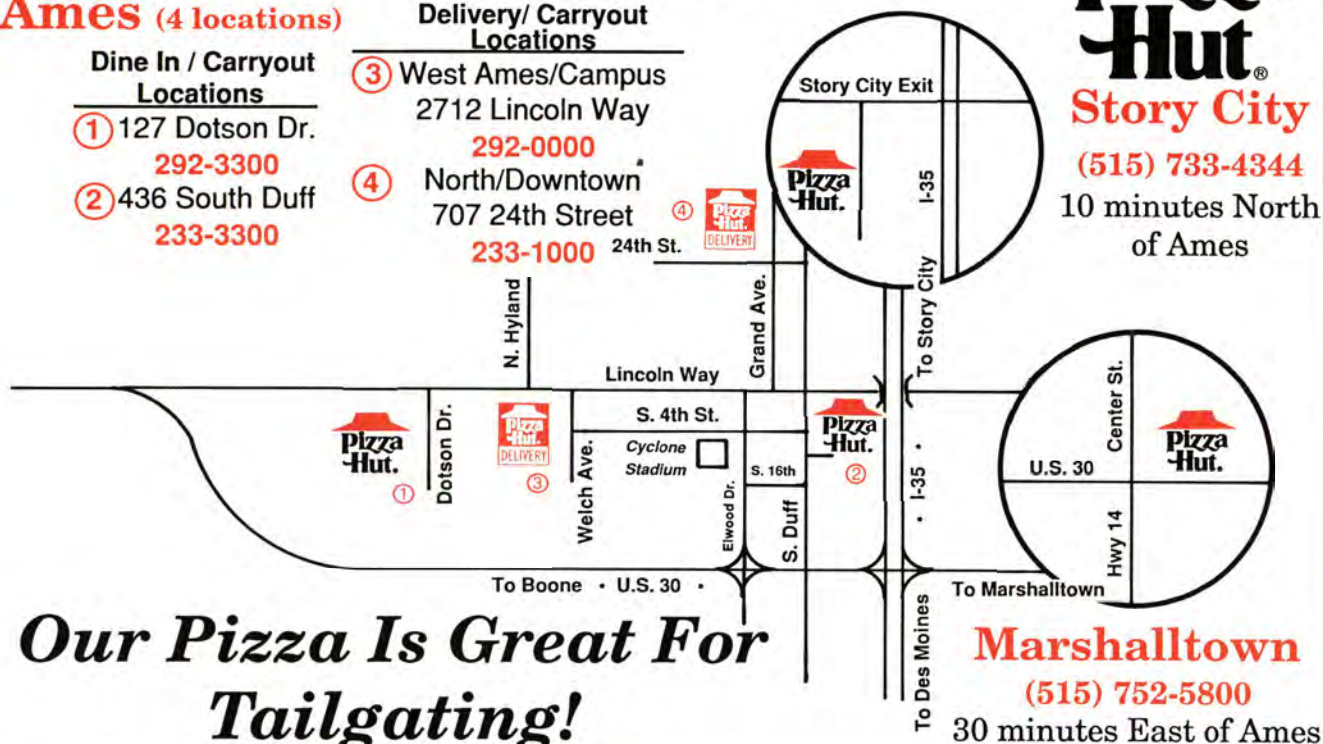

IKE HARRIS, CY'S FAVORITE ALUM

Ike Harris has always endeavored to be the best he could be. From his early days in West Memphis, Ark., he has always applied that determination to any challenge. Today, the former Iowa State gridiron standout is recognized for his numerous achievements, being named by the ISU athletic department as Cy's Favorite Alum for 1991.

An outstanding high school athlete, Harris accepted an Iowa State athletic scholarship in 1970. He played three years as a top pass-catching end for the Cyclones. Harris finished his career with 76 receptions for 1,228 yards and 10 touchdowns. Hill and teammate Willie Jones and

Keith Krepfle were the most potent trio of receivers in school history.

Harris interned with Peat Marwick Mitchell and Co. while earning a bachelor's degree in business administration. The 1974 Iowa State graduate joined the same company under a unique contract that allowed him to take a leave of absence each year from 1975 to 1982 to play in the National Football League. Harris saw action with the St. Louis Cardinals and the New Orleans Saints. He also played one year with the California Sun of the World Football League.

During his 12 years at Peat Marwick Mitchell, Harris was deeply involved in Des Moines civic affairs. He served as president of the board of directors of the Homes of Oakwood, and was on the board of directors of Junior Achievement of Central Iowa. Harris served on the board of governors for the Council on Physical Fitness and Sports, and was a member of Athletes Fighting Substance Abuse. The *Des Moines Register* named him as a 1985-86 "Up and Comer" for contributions to the business and civic organizations in the Capitol City. He also worked with the Hinders Club, Mu Omicron, and Omega Psi Phi.

Harris has worked behind the scene for the Iowa State University Alumni Association, and has served as a member of the Board of Governors of the Iowa State Foundation. He was named "Outstanding Young Alumnus" by ISU in 1987.

His wide range of personal honors include the Aulmann Memorial Award, given for outstanding academic and leadership credentials. He was named Black Student-Athlete of the Year in 1974.

In 1987, while working as senior audit manager for Peat Marwick Mitchell, Harris was named director of internal control for Minneapolis-based Super Valu Stores, Inc. Earlier this year he was promoted to vice president and corporate controller.

Harris has continued his interest in young people by becoming involved in the financial aspects of INVITE, a program that helps inner-city youth to "stay off the streets."

Ike and his wife Charlene, who met as freshman at Iowa State, now live in Plymouth, Minn. They are the parents of a son, Sol, and a daughter, Sonya.

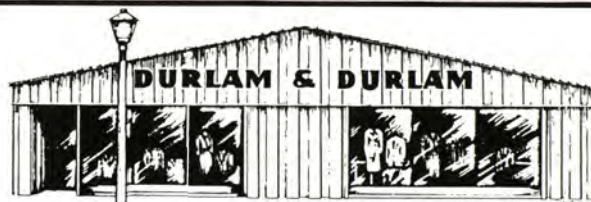

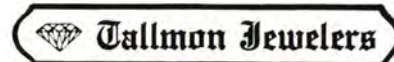

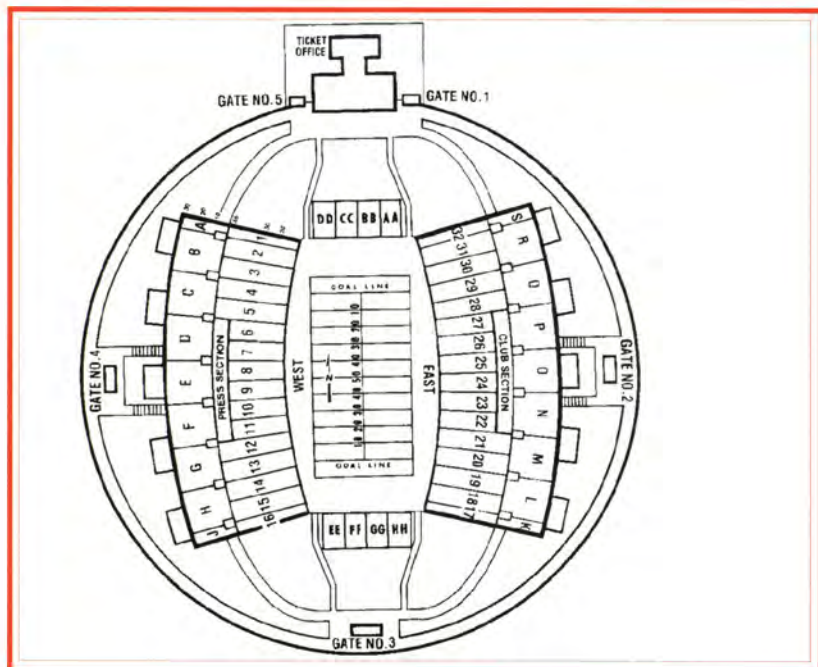

STADIUM INFORMATION



First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked at the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-admission. No pass outs will be allowed between 12:30 and 1 p.m. or 1/2 hour before kickoff.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Lost and Found

A lost and found service is maintained in the Athletic Ticket Office in the Olsen Building at the north end of the stadium. Articles found should be turned over to an usher or left at the Athletic Ticket Office.

Public Telephone

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Refreshments

Refreshments are served in the stands and at locations around the stadium.

Iowa State Souvenirs

An attractive array of Iowa State souvenirs is available at conveniently located novelty sales booths throughout the stadium and from vendors in the parking areas.

Radios, Stadium Chairs, Umbrellas

As a courtesy to neighboring ticket holders, spectators are asked not to bring radios, stadium chairs and umbrellas into the stands.

Rest Rooms

Rest rooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Public Address System

No appeals will be made over the public address system except under special circumstances. The public is asked not to request this service.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.

The State of Iowa code prohibits the use of alcohol in the Stadium. The Athletic Department asks our patrons to behave responsibly and in compliance with the State code.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located in strategic spots throughout the stadium parking area.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. Signs are to be displayed on the south end of the Olsen Building and on the walls of the stands, both upper and lower desks. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Iowa State's Athletic Department. For sign approval, see Bill Goldring, Room 137 Olsen Building before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide an Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 292-2303. Proof of game attendance (i.e.; ticket stub) may be requested.

Distractions

We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage you to be respectful of those around you in the stadium. This attitude of cooperation can help to insure a pleasant enthusiastic game atmosphere. In the event you feel there is unreasonable distraction in your seating area, we ask you to take the following steps to help us control undesirable behavior:

—Note the seating section, row and seat numbers, and inform the usher in your section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.

—If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvement of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.

—An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignment.

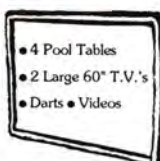

SCOUTING REPORT

The Series: Oklahoma State has a 19-12-1 series advantage over Iowa State. OSU owns a 9-7 mark in Ames. Last year the Cowboys defeated ISU in Ames by a score of 25-17. Gerald Hudson, the NCAA rushing leader in 1990, ran for 264 yards to lead Oklahoma State.

Last Weekend: The Cowboys fell to 0-6 as the Missouri Tigers defeated OSU by a score of 41-7 in Columbia. Oklahoma State was down 14-7 after the first quarter, but Missouri scored 21 points in the second quarter to take a commanding 35-7 lead at halftime. The Cowboys' only was on a 12-yard TD pass from Kenny Ford to L.G. Thompson.

Offensively: Oklahoma State totalled 261 yards last week against Missouri. Freshman tailback Rafael Denson led the OSU rushing attack, gaining 91 yards on 16 carries. He leads the team in rushing with 257 yards. Ford threw for 99 yards last week. The senior is the Cowboys' total offense leader with 123.2 yards per game. The past four seasons, OSU averaged 409.9 yards per game. This year, the offensive output is down to 259.5 yards per game.

Defensively: The Cowboys' defense is lead by three sophomores, right end Jason Gildon, middle linebacker Clarence Nobles and free safety Scott Harmon. Gildon has 20 tackles this season including 6.5 sacks for a total loss of 35 yards. Nobles leads the team in tackles with 42. Harmon has 29 tackles and leads OSU with four interceptions. He is one of the Big Eight's best kickoff returners, averaging 23.3 yards.

Kicking: Redshirt freshman Rick Myers takes over the placekicking duties this season with the departure of three-time all-Big Eight kicker Cary Blanchard. Myers is the Cowboys' top scorer this fall with 18 points. He is four of five on field-goal attempts with a long three-pointer of 37 yards. Senior Barry Vincent has punted 39 times for an average of 33.4 yards.

The Coach: Head coach Pat Jones has a 52-35 record in just over seven years at Oklahoma State. Jones only needs seven victories to become the winningest coach in Cowboy history. The 1969 Arkansas graduate has been at OSU since 1978, when he was an assistant to Jimmy Johnson.

Courageous 1971 Sun Bowl Team Honored on 20th Anniversary



When Johnny Majors set these goals, he knew they were lofty. An Iowa State squad hadn't experienced a winning season since 1960. In addition, Majors lost more than 20 lettermen, including eight defensive starters, from his 1970 squad that finished 5-6. Even more insurmountable, a Cyclone team hadn't made a post-game bowl appearance since ISU's first snap of the football in 1892.

But, Majors was notorious for his optimism, and he piloted his team through a rugged Big Eight Conference slate that included the nation's three top teams—Nebraska, Oklahoma, and Colorado.

Following ISU's 54-0 thrashing of Oklahoma State, the Cyclones achieved their ultimate goal when Athletic Director Lou McCullough accepted an invitation to the 1971 Sun Bowl.

"This has been the greatest year of our lives," Majors said following the season. "A lot of great things have happened to our players, coaches and fans."

Today the Iowa State Athletic Department honors the competitive spirit and determination of the 1971 Sun Bowl squad. Over 30 members of this team, including Majors, have returned to Ames to celebrate the 20th anniversary of this courageous team. And, what memories there are to look back upon.

After defeating Kansas and Kansas State in conference action, the Cyclones faced the task of battling No. 1 Nebraska and No. 2 Oklahoma back to back. Although they lost both contests, the Cyclones gave valliant efforts, including a defense stand that held Nebraska to 10 points for over 26 minutes.

After falling to the national powerhouses, the Cyclones rebounded with a 45-17 win over Missouri, giving ISU its second straight triumph over the Tigers. Iowa State hadn't defeated Mizzou two consecutive seasons since George Veenker led his 1933 and 1934 squads over the Tigers.

Majors rode off Clyde Williams Field on the shoulders of his players after Iowa State's win over Oklahoma State. The fourth Big Eight victory gave ISU an upper-division finish for the first time in six years. In the game, Amundson rushed for four touchdowns and passed to Willie Jones for another to earn Big Eight Player of the Week honors.

Iowa State tallied 556 yards total offense, including 310 through the air, as the Cyclones downed San Diego State, 48-31, the next weekend. It was the first time since 1906 that an ISU squad had tallied eight wins in a season.

Making their first-ever national television appearance, the Cyclones fought a tough battle in the Sun Bowl, but lost to No. 10 Louisiana State, 33-15, to close the book on the one of Iowa State's finest seasons ever.

"Our goals—to have the "winningest" team in modern Iowa State history, finish in the top division of the Big Eight Conference, and to go to a bowl game."
